



Notice of Race

Seattle Pink Boat Regatta – September 9th, 2023

This event is organized by the Pink Boat Regatta, a 501 (c) 3 non-profit corporation supporting The Breast Cancer Research through sailing with 100% of all net proceeds.

This event is considered a 'Fun' race. Boats are expected to abide by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, common sense and a spirit of service. **DON'T BE A JERK.** If you foul someone or may have fouled someone, do a 360 degree turn and continue the race. Keep it safe, kind and courteous on the water, this is a charity fundraiser after all! The race committee is a bunch of people who are out here for a good cause and a good time and will reserve the right to disqualify any boats that don't resolve their differences on the water.

Time: First warning is expected to be at 12:00pm.

Eligibility and Registration: The race is open to all boats under sail. Vessels may [register here](#).

Moorage: Moorage will be available for race day on a first come basis on dock X at the north end of Shilshole marina. Boats are asked to raft to the degree practicable to accommodate others. For overnight moorage needs please coordinate directly with Shilshole Bay Marina at (206) 787-3006. Overnight moorage is not included in your race registration and must be paid directly to the Port of Seattle.

Mandatory Pre-Race Meeting: A mandatory pre-race meeting (party!) will be held in person at 10am Saturday, September 9th in the CYC Clubhouse. All participants are encouraged to join.

Awards Party: The party/awards program will begin at the conclusion of racing. This race has a 3-hour time limit, so the party portion of the program is slated to begin at 15:00-15:30.
